Sometimes, I will have my blood pressure taken. A special bracelet is put around my arm and gives it a squeeze. It doesn't last too long, and then it is all done.







For checkups, I may go get my vision and my hearing checked.






Once the nurse is all done with the measuring, I wait in the exam room for the doctor to come in.
